Overview

The Public Health Data Standards Consortium (Consortium) re-launched the [Ad Hoc Task Force on Electronic Health Record-Public Health \(EHR-PH Task Force\)](#) in collaboration with the Health Level Seven (HL7) Electronic Health Record (EHR) Working Group. **Ninety three (93) participants joined the Consortium in re-evaluation of the HL7 EHR Systems (EHR-S) Functional Model (FM) Release 1.1.** Participants offered perspectives from local, state and federal public health agencies, healthcare organizations, public health professional associations, schools of public health, health IT vendor organizations, private sector, and individuals interested in public health.

Purpose

This webinar will present the outcomes of the re-evaluation process and recommendations for engaging public health into standardization of clinical and public health EHR-S-based information exchanges.
